

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FOREWORD

KHANA is a non-governmental organization registered with the Ministry of Interior (since 2000). It began as a project of the UK-based International HIV/AIDS Alliance in 1996. Since then it has significantly scaled up its programs and coverage; it currently provides financial and technical support to 38 local partners in 20 provinces and municipalities, enabling them to develop more effective community responses to HIV and AIDS.

KHANA Strategic Plan 2016-2020 explicitly shows the integrated HIV programming with other diseases, including TB, at KHANA and implementing partners. KHANA has been a member of Sub-Technical Working Group for TB Control (Sub-TWG) led by the National Center for TB and Leprosy Control (CENAT), which meets every month to discuss TB guidelines, assessments, and program challenges at the field implementation level. At the community level, KHANA and implementing partners work in collaboration with community DOTS watchers and village health support groups (VHSG) in relation to community education, TB awareness raising, and referral linkages with the focus on TB/HIV integration. Under the care, treatment and support program, KHANA and its implementing partners actively refer TB patients to Voluntary Confidential Counseling and Testing (VCCT) for HIV test and vice versa as a dual referral approach. KHANA currently is planning to gather information and response mechanisms concerning TB and HIV at national, sub-national and community levels.

In order to engage community responses to TB in Cambodia, KHANA has signed an agreement with Stop TB Partnership to collaborate with NGOs working on TB to identify gaps, barriers, and challenges of TB implementation at national, sub-national and community levels. To do this, KHANA has conducted an assessment by interviewing CENAT, US-CDC, a TB representative, an NGO representative at Country Coordination Mechanism (CCM), and NGOs both active and non-active in TB. After the assessment, KHANA has organized a consultation workshop with the participants to share and discuss the preliminary findings, a draft TB informational directory, a draft event calendar, and a draft engagement work plan. These documents have been examined and verified at another consultation workshop with the participants and at a meeting with CENAT.

This directory contains key information about 16 NGOs active in TB and four NGOs non-active in TB. You will find their profiles, including details of their background and programs, geographic coverage, target groups, and major activities. We hope that this directory is a stepping stone to build and strengthen a civil society and community network to better contribute to the national TB responses. The profiles should give you some ideas about the range of activities carried out by NGOs working on TB in Cambodia. If you wish to obtain more information, please contact them directly.





- 1. Support TB patients to access TB services, follow up for medical care, sputum control and drug refills at the health facilities.
- 2. Provide training and technical assistance to health facility staff, community structures and C-DOTS Watchers to up date the knowledge and skills on TB in gap areas including the referral for HIV testing
- 3. Strengthen the referral system between community structures and health facilities so that the severe ill TB patients receive timely treatment.
- 4. Strengthen and maintain the existing C-DOTS Watchers in Thmor Kol, Pailin and Oddar Meanchey.
- 5. Carry out TB awareness, prevention and care seeking through health centers, community health education.
- 6. Improve the detection of TB in patient contacts through technical assistance to service providers in counseling, screening and referral procedures for contacts and education to patients.
